The School has a broad scheme of scholarships the number and value of which depend upon funds available through donation. These include:

- Achievement Scholarships
- Bursaries for needy and worthy students, the number and value depending upon funds available through donation. Priority in these cases is given to applicants of the upper school classes.
- Extra-curricular activities scholarships
- In addition to the above the school covers tuition fees in case of family emergencies.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scholarship Committee will decide on Extra Curricular Awards and Scholarships.

CRITERIA

- a) Any scholarship will only apply for the academic year in which it is awarded and will take into account other American Academy scholarships or awards gained by the student. The financial value of the award will be taken from next year's tuition fees.
- b) Students will be eligible to apply if they meet all three criteria:
 1. They have prepared for and entered the competition through the American Academy Larnaca and have succeeded (i.e. ranked 1st, 2nd or 3rd) at official Pancyprian or International competitions or events, or are officially ranked in continental or international (including at least 4 other major nations) or world competitions (e.g. Olympics).
 2. Their conduct in school is excellent or has improved to become excellent.
 3. They are not failing in any subject in the current or the previous year.

1. These rules and regulations are subject to change from time to time at the discretion of the Scholarships Committee.

2. The school reserves the right to make changes to these rules and regulations without prior notification.

3. All scholarships and awards are made at the sole discretion of the Scholarships Committee, whose decision is final.

4. All scholarships / bursaries awarded are deducted from student's fees. 5. These rules and regulations apply from 1st September 2017.
