



# Maths Policy

## New Curriculum requirements

From September 2015, Little Big Maths and Big Maths will be introduced from EY - G5.

From September 2015, G1 –G5 will follow the 2014 maths curriculum objectives.

G6 will follow the 2014 maths curriculum objectives, in addition to any other specific objectives and timing required for successful transitioning to Year 1 Senior School.

## Mid-term plans

G1-6 will write dates, resources and activities on MT plans.

Objectives to be covered in Big Maths will also be highlighted on the MT plan.

EY and PJ will use the existing MT planning format.

## Objectives

G1-6 will cover the objectives in the pathways chart organised into the 4 strands: number sense, additive reasoning, multiplicative reasoning and geometric reasoning.

G1-6 will use the planning framework and teaching sequences devised by Rising Stars.

PJ will use the mixed reception/year 1 new maths objectives from Hamilton Trust planning as a framework.

EY will use Early Learning Goals in their existing planning format.

## Weekly Plans

The weekly maths planning sheet will be used by G1-6. Teachers must give consideration to all sections of the planning sheet including key questions, success criteria, thinking skills, WWO, SOLO, Erasmus, Portfolio and evaluation sections.

The weekly plan will be handed to the Department Leader every Monday. These will be passed onto the Head teacher.

## Cross-Curricular Links

Where possible, maths links will be made with termly themes.
