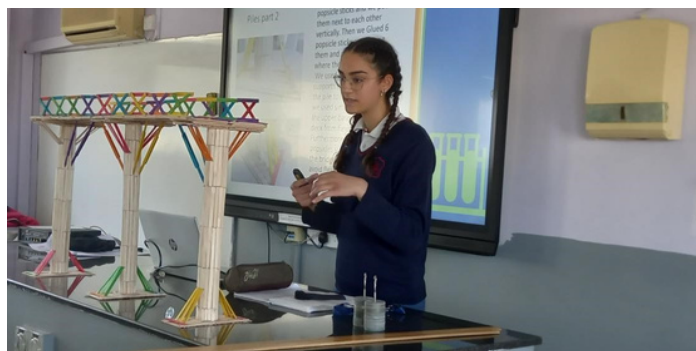


STEM Projects

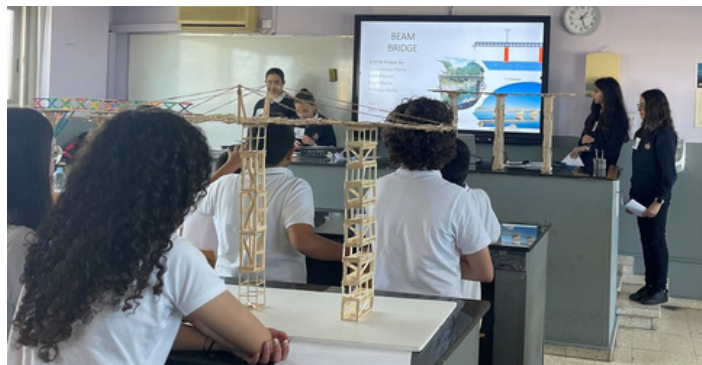
During this year's STEM projects, our students designed and built a bridge using sustainable materials.

The main goal of this year-long extracurricular activity was to allow the students to use their creativity and to help them further develop their problem-solving skills through project-based learning.

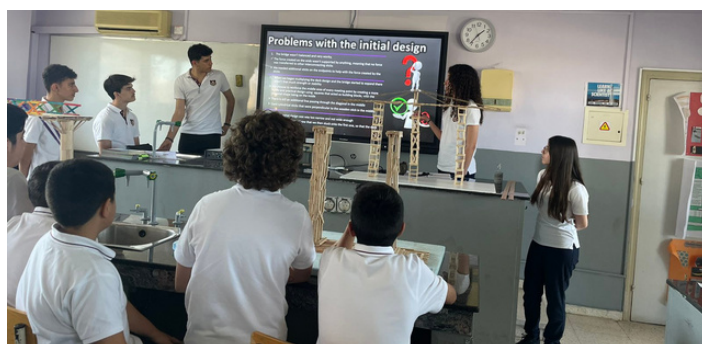
