Our Business Club students visited top Larnaca firms, gaining real-world insights.



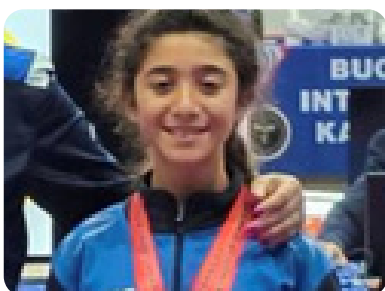
