

SUMMER SCHOOL 2026

Dear Parents / Guardians,



The American Academy Larnaca Summer School welcomes you to another exciting summer adventure!

Our Summer School Programme is designed for children aged 3 to 14 years old. Children are grouped by age and enjoy a structured, engaging experience alongside their teachers and peers. With the guidance of our skilled and qualified staff, they will have valuable opportunities for learning, creativity, and personal growth in a safe, supportive, and educational environment.

This year's seven-week programme will run from Monday, 22nd June until Friday, 7th August 2026. It offers a balanced combination of academic learning, creative activities, physical education, and team-based experiences, all organised through a carefully planned daily timetable.

All sessions are delivered by qualified educators and instructors with experience in their subject areas. The programme is designed to support students' learning, creativity, physical development, and cooperation through structured and supervised activities.

Programme Activities (for children joining Grade 1 and above in September 2026)

Academic Learning

Students participate in guided sessions that develop thinking, communication, and foundational knowledge:

- STEM – Practical activities introducing science, technology, engineering, and mathematics
- IT Skills – Introduction to basic computer skills and digital tools
- English – Development of language and communication skills through interactive exercises

Creative Activities

Activities that encourage creativity and self-expression:

- Art – Drawing, painting, and creative crafts
- Music – Exploring sounds and rhythm
- Dance – Basic movements and simple choreography



Physical Education

Sports sessions focus on skill development, coordination, and understanding rules, similar to school Physical Education lessons:

- Football – Dribbling, passing, shooting, and game rules
- Basketball – Dribbling, passing, shooting, and rules of the game
- Handball – Ball control, passing, shooting, and rules
- Table Tennis – Forehand, backhand, and rules
- Badminton – Clear shot, forehand, backhand, and rules
- Karate – Basic techniques with emphasis on discipline and self-control



Team and Thinking Activities

Activities that develop teamwork, coordination, and problem-solving skills:

- Survivor Challenges – Balance, coordination, cooperation, and confidence
- Dodgeball – Teamwork and cooperation
- Educational Games – Learning through play
- Board Games – Strategy, concentration, and social interaction
- Bingo – Group participation and number recognition



Children between 3–6 years old (who will join the pre-junior class and below in September 2026) will follow an indoor schedule in our nursery classrooms, based on weekly themes (e.g., ice cream, pirates & mermaids, animals, Disney heroes, etc.). In addition, they will take part in age-appropriate activities such as creative play, basic academic skills, music, movement, arts and crafts, and introductory physical activities.
